In 2022, Alzheimer's Society Dementia Action Week encouraged people who are concerned that they or someone they know may be experiencing dementia symptoms to seek further help. Increasing diagnosis rates is such an important issue that we're focusing on it again this year. Following a sustained drop in dementia diagnosis rates for the first time ever, we undertook research to understand the key barriers and benefits to getting a diagnosis.

As well as the misconception around <u>memory loss just being part of getting old</u>, our research found being in denial, and referral times to specialists, are big barriers for those experiencing symptoms to seek a diagnosis.

Where can I find more information on memory loss and diagnosis?

It's important that those who are concerned that they or someone close to them might be experiencing signs of dementia continue to come to us for guidance and support.

This includes reading our new information on <u>memory loss and diagnosis</u>, using our <u>symptoms checklist</u> to help describe symptoms to GPs, and watching <u>first-hand stories</u> from people living with and affected by dementia on the benefits of getting a diagnosis.
