

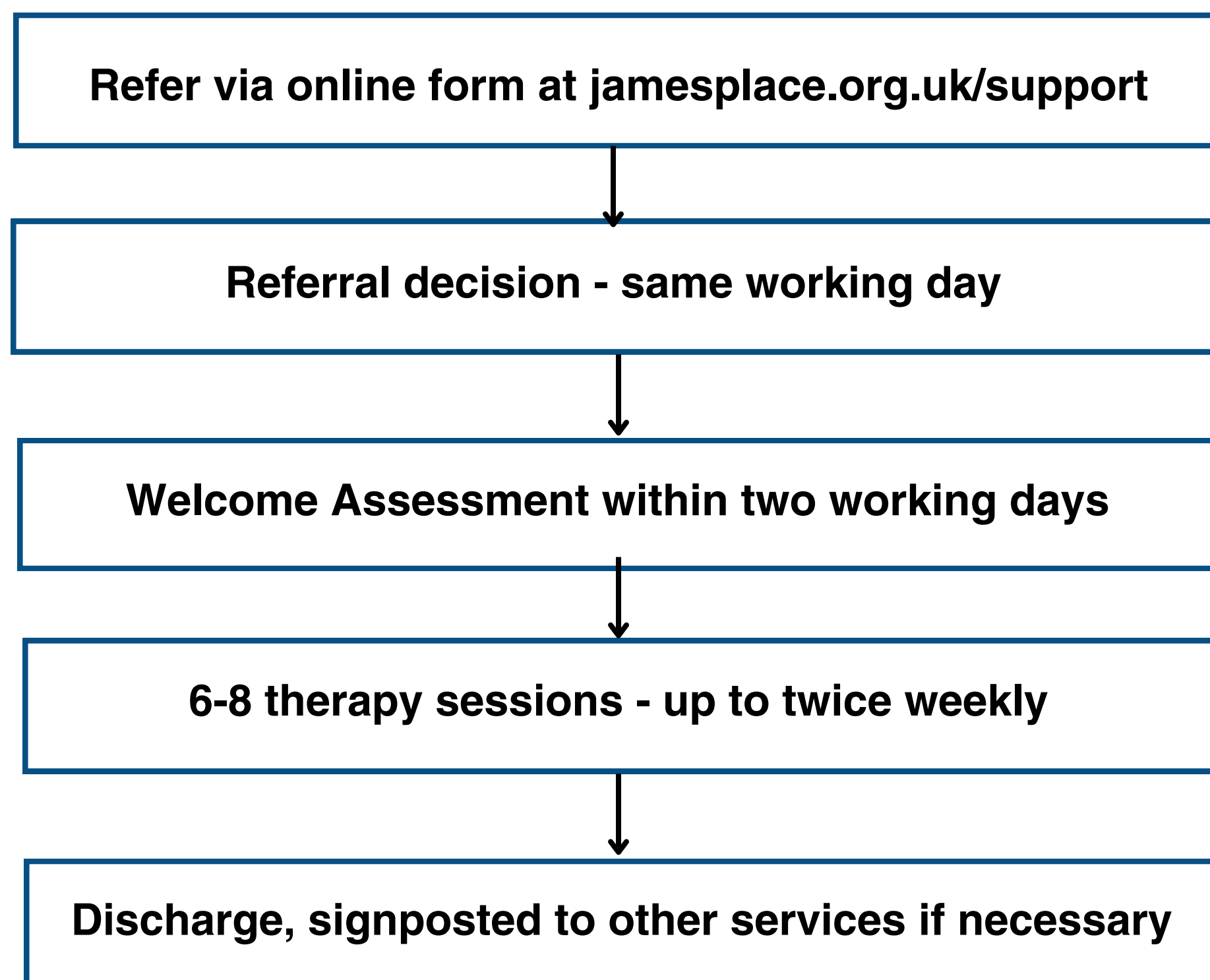
JAMES' PLACE REFERRAL CRITERIA

James' Place offers free treatment for men in suicidal crisis delivered by trained, professional therapists at our satellite service based at Citizen's Advice Darlington, Redcar and Cleveland.

We will see men that meet the threshold for Home Based Treatment and are agreeable to come to see us at our satellite service.

Referrals must meet the following criteria:

- Men 18+ (or anyone that identifies as male).
- Experiencing a suicidal crisis primarily driven by psycho-social stressors rather than an enduring mental illness. We do not have access to medics/psychiatrists therefore do not offer urgent medical reviews.
- Able to engage and benefit from a short term talking therapy. Much like the Crisis Team, James' Place will not exclude men that are using alcohol and/or illicit substances, but daily or dependant use and a refusal to have this addressed would not meet James' Place criteria.
- Not accessing, or eligible for, secondary mental health care. If they have been referred to CTT but not yet been assessed, they can be referred to us as we will not consider them to be engaging with a secondary mental health service.
- Willing to work with us and register with a GP.
