TV Licences for over 75's

TV Licensing will be writing to you to tell you whether or not you will have to pay for a licence. You may have already received your letter.

An information booklet and 3 payment application forms (Form A, B and C) will be enclosed with the letter.

There will also be details of how you can pay for your new licence including ordering a 75+ Plan payment card. This card will help you spread the cost of paying by weekly, fortnightly or monthly at no extra cost.

If you haven't heard from TV Licensing by the end of October you should contact them.
